DIGITAL VIDEO RECORDING

A good digital video recorder (DVR) adds an enormous amount of value to your video surveillance system. Spending the time to research your options and invest in a quality DVR will help you get the most out of any surveillance system. The main component that drives the features and functionality of the DVR and the cameras attached to it is the DVR software capabilities. DVR

software comes preloaded on most stand-alone DVR's purchased today. Let us consider some of the features you should look for in DVR software. **Motion detection**— There are many levels of functionality related to this feature that may vary based on the software application you are considering. At the very least, you should have the ability to trigger camera recording when motion is detected. A

great feature to look for is the ability to trigger electronic alerts when your cameras sense motion. This can either be an automated email alert with video clip attached, or in some instances even an alert sent directly to your mobile phone.

Camera control and configuration— You should be able to adjust image resolution on a per camera basis. Some applications offer the (cont. page 2)

DIGITAL VIDEO RECORDING (CONTINUED)

The ability to automatically adjust image resolution based on a pre-configured event trigger. This is a great feature to have, but is not as critical as being able to manually adjust camera resolution. Other camera control features you should look for are pan/tilt/zoom functionality, ability to adjust video capture rate, and the ability to remotely view captured video through an Internet web browser.

Alarm and event logs— Quality DVR software allows for the ability to track and monitor alarm triggering events through a time stamped event log.

This gives you a better understanding of details surrounding the event.

Video search and archival functionality— Another feature that may not seem as critical, but can save you a tremendous amount of time is an intuitive video archival system with advanced search functionality. This makes it much easier to store your video and perform searches based on specified criteria. This also makes the process of reviewing your video much more efficient.

Networking capabilities— The ability to put a DVR on a LAN or WAN would allow for viewing of recorded video anywhere

the network is accessible via remote software, and may be set up to view video off site. This is another feature that makes managing a video system much easier for busy security manager. Digital video recording is not a mystery, however when you look at all of the models and features available it can seem a bit overwhelming. PUBLIC SAFETY PAGING

The latest devices for Public Safety alerting are the **Motorola Minitor V pager** and the Veetronix Alert Receiver.

The Motorola Minitor V Pager is a new generation voice pager which is ideal for fire departments as well as businesses and other organizations that must react quickly in times of emergency.

The Minitor V is available in Low-Band, VHF and UHF ; 1 or 2 channel with or without stored voice option.

Dual frequency models have a programmable priority scan option. VHF and UHF models have wide or narrow-band programmable channel spacing. Expanded stored voice records up to 8 minutes of voice message for playback. The Minitor V pager has 12 alert tones available per channel. It supports 8 two-tone pairs and 4 individual long-tone alerts(8second tones). There are also 10

different musical alerts to choose from for each tone, plus vibrate, or both vibrate and tone alerting. Pagers with the stored voice option can also announce the programmed operating mode when selected. The Minitor V meets MIL standard 810 E procedures 1 for driving rain, and is UL certified as Intrinsically Safe1. It includes a fast charger, NiMH battery pack, user guide and one year warranty. Triangle recommends the option for 5 yrs.
